Special Notes:

All seniors who expect to go through the line must be at the commencement practices. Please make the appropriate arrangement with employers, etc.-----Please notify your counselor ASAP if you are not planning on participating in commencement ceremonies.

-Art work must be appropriate on caps.

-Caps and gowns are to be worn at Graduation Rehearsal on May 28th.

-Baccalaureate is not a required event; however, we would encourage you and your parents to attend.

-If you plan to attend college, you must request that your final transcript to be sent as soon as possible. All fees and fines must be paid before release of an official transcript. Please request your transcript in the counseling office.

Counselors will also bring transcript request forms to graduation practice.

-Seniors may not camp out or otherwise hang out on school grounds during any nights prior to, or following graduation.

-All fees and fines must be paid prior to receipt of your diploma and/or yearbook. A list of all fees and fines owed will be posted in the office window beginning May 1st. Please check weekly for updates. **Fee payments will not be taken the night of Graduation. Any students not receiving their diploma must return the day after to resolve all issues.**

-Please be sure to clean out your locker prior to graduation.

-Each graduate participating in the commencement exercises will receive 6 admission tickets. Students may request additional tickets by filling out and completing a ticket request form (Max 2 tickets). Forms will be available in the main office beginning on May 6th. All request forms must be turned in by 4:00 pm on May 20th. These additional tickets will be handed out at the 24th rehearsal.
